¹³ For I have heard the whispering of the crowd;
fear is on every side;
they scheme together against me,
and plot to take my life.

¹⁴ But my trust is in you, O Lord.
I have said, 'You are my God.

¹⁵ 'My times are in your hand;
deliver me from the hand of my enemies,
and from those who persecute me.

¹⁶ 'Make your face to shine upon your servant,
and save me for your mercy's sake.'

Comment *This is a prayer in the times of ordeal. 'My times are in your hand' (v.15) invokes the ancient belief that the times of birth and death are pre-determined by the deity.*
