There is something for everyone and we do look forward to welcoming you to both our churches over Easter time. Lent has been a time of journeying, of going deeper, of reflection and transformation. We have shared an enriching time of Ignatian reflection on Tuesday evenings and for some of us an exciting trip to Coventry Cathedral with its theme of new beginnings rising from a place of despair and destruction.

We have shared the story of Easter with care home residents and with children from Velmead school and also with our P & J pre-schoolers. In each place there has been time for reflection and encounter. For some, the journey has taken an unexpected turn and we continue to pray with and for Mark, for healing and recovery. In Holy week the going becomes challenging as we celebrate Jesus' last supper, watch and pray with him at Gethsemane and then walk the journey of the cross together on Good Friday (with three different services on offer). Doing the journey is important as we experience together Jesus' betrayal, his pain and suffering, the fear and the waiting. Placing our own struggles and suffering at the cross helps us know that God's love never leaves us, even in death and that we can celebrate the joy of forgiveness and eternal life as we greet each other on Easter morning with the acclamation, 'Christ is risen, he is risen indeed'. For the early risers, do join us at 7.30am at P & J as we light our Paschal candles and celebrate the light of Christ in our churches and the world.
