

News Sheet for Sunday 21 July Eighth Sunday after Trinity

WELCOME TO OUR WORSHIP

Welcome in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ to our worship today. It is a great joy to have you with us as we worship God together. If you are with us for the first time, please do make yourself known to us after the service.

Two years ago, the PCC and I working together with a team from the Diocese came up with a 'Parish Development Plan' setting our priorities as we saw them at that time. The goals we set ourselves then were:

- 1) To renew our worship programme in order to enable a wider range of people to join us in worship and to make better use of our resources across the Parish.
- 2) To encourage more people to become involved in ministry at all levels.
- 3) To make the best use of the opportunities presented by the reopening of All Saints Church.
- 4) To appoint a Children's and families' worker.

Looking back over the last two years, I believe we have done well on the first three goals. Sadly, though we did try, we failed to appoint a families' worker. We have however worked hard to develop our work in that area through Baby Saints, Godly Play, and now Pizza and Praise.

We are now about to embark upon this process again. This time the diocese are asking us to focus on the goal of building up the 'Core' of our church (those who worship regularly, are confident in their faith, and are able to express their faith in word and action out in the wider community). The aim would be to raise up more people who could be described this way.

I am therefore asking your thoughts on the following questions:

- 1) What could we do or change in order to equip more people from our congregations to be active and visible Christians in their daily lives?
- 2) What might we be doing now that might be preventing this from happening?

I would be really grateful for your thoughts and ideas on this. Please email me at vicar@parishoffleet.org.uk or speak to me after a service or whenever you next see me. I would also be grateful if home groups and other gatherings within the life of the church would have a conversation about this.
