An inspiring textile exhibition by artist Jacqui Parkinson, featuring eighteen large-scale panels reflecting on the life of Jesus. Crafted with vibrant silks, metallic leathers, and gold leaf, these works are bold, beautiful, and deeply moving. 'Threads Through the Cross' forms the third part of an extraordinary trilogy, joining Threads Through Creation and Threads Through Revelation.
