#### **Church of Fleet: All Saints**

NOTICE IS GIVEN that we are applying to the Consistory Court of the diocese for permission to carry out the following:

The Parish Church of All Saints Fleet was devastated by an arson attack in June 2015, which destroyed the roof and much of the interior while leaving the main brick structure intact.

Following extensive consultation with the local community and much detailed work by the Parish and its architects, a set of proposals have been developed which are intended to 'honour the past whilst building for the future'. These proposals include (i) the reordering of the church interior, restoring historic elements that are capable of restoration and sympathetically replacing others that were totally destroyed, (ii) creation of a new west entrance - restoring a feature of the original pre-1930s building and (iii) the construction of a new Annexe to the north side, providing a new Lady Chapel plus other meeting spaces with kitchen and toilet facilities. These proposals together represent an ambitious plan to equip All Saints as both a modern worship space and a community venue, suitable for the needs of the 21st century whilst respecting the historic significance of the building.

A letter of objection must include your name and address and state whether you live in the parish and/or your name is entered on the church electoral roll of the parish or any other basis on which you have an interest in the matter.**

### **Directions to petitioner**

You must display this public notice (or a copy of it) for a continuous period of not less than 28 days, not counting the day on which it was put up or the day on which it is taken down, (or for such other period as the Court may direct and subject to any special directions of the registrar) in each of the following places:

1. on a notice board or in some other prominent position inside the church; and
2. on a notice board outside the church or in some other prominent position (whether on the outside of the church door or elsewhere) so that it can be read by the public.
