WELCOME TO OUR WORSHIP

Welcome in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ to our worship today. It is a great joy to have you with us as we worship God together. If you are with us for the first time, please do make yourself known to us after the service.

In the news this week there has been lots of discussion about the union flag, and where and when it should be flown. Some of this, I regret to say, has centred around a subtext, through which some are seeking to define who is and who is not welcome in this country. What a sad misuse of our flag, which I have always been proud to remember represents an array of cultures coming together - England, Wales, Scotland, Northern Ireland but also St George (A Turk who settled in Palestine) St Andrew (A Galilean Jew) an St David (A Celt, who lived for some time in Brittany). In other words, the 'Union' flag stands as testimony to a nation that has always included and welcomed people from a wide array of nations and cultures. Every time I walk past All Saints Church, I think of our own flag flying there, our parish flag, designed by Sam Lord, which features our parish logo, a cross made up of the figures of many people all of different colours. Seeing this flag flying there makes me quite proud of who we are as a parish! Please be reassured in these fragmented times that all people, regardless of age, gender, race or sexual orientation, are welcome to our worship and will be treated as beloved children of God our heavenly Father.
