<u>BABY SAINTS</u> - Baby Saints will not meet this week due to half term break. Will resume on Wednesday 5 November at FPCC, 10.00am – 12.00pm. If you have or care for preschool children we'd love to see you.

<u>CONFIRMATION SERVICE</u> - There will be a confirmation service at All Saints on Sunday 2 November at 6.30pm. We will be presenting five candidates for confirmation, and we expect to be welcoming others from elsewhere in the deanery. Please pray for those to be confirmed and do come to the service to support them if you are able to.

<u>ACTIVITY AFTERNOON</u> - Many thanks to all who helped with welcome and craft and baking and serving tea last Saturday. We had a great time exploring the story of Zacchaeus together.

<u>HART FOODBANK DONATIONS</u> - Thank you for your gifts to the Foodbank. This week there is an urgent need for mashed potato – packets, sponge puddings, vegetarian meals, household cleaning - sponges, cloths etc., Pasta 'N Sauce packets, men's grooming - deodorant, shaving, razors etc.. Currently we do <u>not</u> need any water, sugar, flour or cereals. Items can be left in the Foodbank containers in the narthex at Ss Philip & James Church and in FPCC. Thank you, as always, for your donations to the foodbank, they are all very much appreciated.

<u>FLEET 10K RACE ROAD CLOSURES</u> - Sunday 26 October, starting time of 9.30am. The route covers Fleet Road, Elvetham Road and Reading Road North and these roads will be fully closed for the duration of the event, with Fleet Road closed from 9am. It will be possible to cross Fleet Road at the Church Road junction until 9.25am. There is no morning service at All Saints, but this may affect your journey to P&J.

<u>CHURCH ROAD CLOSURE DUE TO CARRIAGEWAY REPAIRS</u> – On Monday 3 November 8.00am – 4.00pm. Vehicular access to property during works will be possible although there may be delays whilst hot materials are allowed to cool. Pedestrian access will always be available.
