



*ff* O BE joyful in God ' all ye ' lands : sing praises unto the honour of his Name, make his ' praise ' to be ' glorious.

2 Say unto God, O how wonderful art thou ' in thy ' works : through the greatness of thy power shall thine enemies be found ' liars ' unto ' thee.

*mf* 3 For all the ' world shall ' worship thee : sing of ' thee and ' praise thy ' Name.

4 O come hither and behold the ' works of ' God : how wonderful he is in his doing ' toward the ' children of ' men.

5 He turned the sea into ' dry ' land : so that they went through the water on foot, there did ' we re'joice there'of.

6 He ruleth with his power for ever, his eyes be'hold the ' people : and such as will not believe, shall not be ' able to ex'alt them'selves.

7 O praise our ' God ye ' people : and make the ' voice of his ' praise to be ' heard;

*p* 8 Who holdeth our ' soul in ' life : and suffereth ' not our ' feet to ' slip.

*f* 9 For thou O ' God hast ' proved us : thou also hast tried us ' like as ' silver is ' tried.

10 Thou broughtest us ' into the ' snare : and laigest ' trouble up'on our ' loins.

*mp* 11 Thou sufferedst men to ride ' over our ' heads : we went through fire and water, and thou broughtest us out ' into a ' wealthy ' place.

12 I will go into thine house with ' burnt'offerings : and will pay thee my vows, which I promised with my lips and spake with my mouth ' when I ' was in ' trouble.

*mf* 13 I will offer unto thee fat burnt-sacrifices, with the ' incense of ' rams : I will ' offer ' bullocks and ' goats.

14 O come hither and hearken, all ye that ' fear ' God : and I will tell you what ' he hath ' done for my ' soul.

15 I called unto him ' with my ' mouth : and gave him ' praises ' with my ' tongue.

16 If I incline unto wickedness ' with mine ' heart : the ' Lord ' will not ' hear me.

*f* 17 But ' God hath ' heard me : and considered the ' voice of my ' prayer.

18 Praised be God who hath not cast ' out my ' prayer : nor ' turned his ' mercy ' from me.

*mf* Glory be to the Father, and ' to the ' Son : and ' to the ' Holy ' Ghost ; As it was in the beginning, is now and ' ever ' shall be : world without ' end.' A'men.
